Please send your child to school with a bottle filled with water each day.


As the weather becomes warmer your child will need a named hat and a named small bottle of sun cream.


# **Dear Parent/Carers**

#### **Themes**

## **English**

Our phonics teaching through Read, Write, Inc continues and most children have learnt all of the set 1 and set 2 sounds. Their reading is becoming more fluent and they are able to read some words without sounding them out. Our focus this half term is to continue to develop fluency and comprehension. There are questions in the reading books that you can ask your child to check for understanding. In writing we are continuing to write sentences that can be read by others and we are aiming to write longer pieces, developing writing stamina. The children are checking, correcting and editing their work sometimes publishing a final piece. Letter formation and handwriting is also a key focus at the moment.

### **Other News**

Now that the weather is warmer, we have got some caterpillars to experience the phenomena of metamorphosis, putting into action the learning we did on life cycles in the spring term.

We have also opened our outdoor snack area where the children can choose, prepare and eat fruit, washing up their equipment ready for the next child.
