# **Dear Parent/Carers**

With SATs only weeks away, we will be making sure that pupils are very well prepared for the tests. The last booster session will be Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April.

# **Maths**

In maths, we will be focusing on geometry, ratio and proportion. We will also be recapping and revising previous subjects in preparation for SATs.

After SATs, we will start to look at the Year 7 Maths curriculum in preparation for High School.

# How you can help your child:

Please ensure your child arrives at school on time.

Please listen to your child read and discuss what they have read every night. Ensure reading records are signed.

Please check your child brings their reading book, reading record and their homework planner to school every day.

Please help and encourage your child to complete their homework. Homework is now revision using the CGP books.

Please ensure children have their PE kit on a Tuesday and Friday.

#### Science

This half-term we will study Forces. We will identify how forces act on different objects. We will explore the effect gravity has on objects and how air resistance affects moving objects.

# **English**

Continuing on from Spring term, there will be a focus on developing our core skills across the English curriculum. This will continue to involve lots of reading across all lessons to develop stamina, speed and improve our comprehension skills. This will be coupled with lots of spelling, punctuation, grammar and handwriting work to ensure children have the necessary skills to write successfully with increasing independence. The importance of practicing these spellings at home, as well as in class, has never been greater. Our class text is 'Cogheart' This book will form the basis for all our English work. We will also look to use our improving writing skills across other subject areas.

# **History**

Children will research and use analytical skills as a historian to explore the Victorians.

# Geography

In Geography, children will be using an atlas to identify mountain ranges across the world. We will then look at key features of a river system and how important rivers are to different societies across the world.

# Computing

The first half of this term we will be revisiting the everpopular coding software, Scratch. The children will be creating an animated scene from the Canon text, Cogheart, by creating algorithms for a number of sprites. In the second half of this term they will be planning and recording a radio advert for the maze game they made in the Spring term using Audacity recording software.

#### PΕ

Our PE lessons will be on Tuesday and Friday. On a Tuesday, we will be focusing on cricket. On a Friday, we have Mr Parker from Ackworth, who will be leading table tennis lessons until half term. After half term, we will be focusing on Athletics in preparation for sports day.

#### Art

We will be creating an embroidery hoop image of a mechanical animal using printing techniques, glue and thread. We will also be learning new skills such as blanket, back and cross stitch.

# **Design Technology**

Children will design, create, test and evaluate a moving scene from our class text 'Cogheart' we will be creating levers, gears and pulley's

# **Spanish**

Children will have the opportunity to build on prior learning by having conversations about their appearance, describing their favourite hobbies and becoming confident using Spanish dictionaries.
