



Year 2 Autumn Term One Curriculum Overview

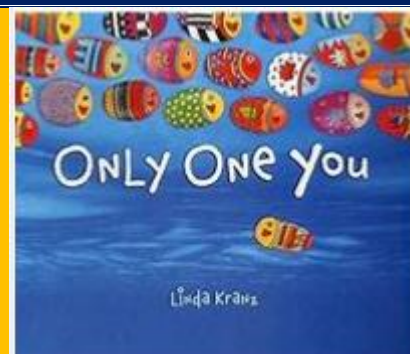

Welcome to the Autumn Term. We very much hope that our children have been able to enjoy a wonderfully restful summer break and that they are raring to go as they commence another successful school year. As always, time flies and we are starting yet another school year. This curriculum overview contains information about what you and, more importantly, your child should expect in Year 2. This term we have a new book: *Only One You*. This is the story of Adri the fish. Adri's parents share some of the wisdom they have gained through the years with their eager son. Their words, simple and powerful, are meant to comfort and guide him as he goes about exploring the world.

Reading, Writing, Maths and Science

To start with, there will be an emphasis on writing simple sentences that are correctly punctuated. We will also involve plenty of reading across all lessons to develop our reading stamina, reading speed and improve our comprehension skills. Children will receive spellings for this half term. These will be tested in school every Friday. For the first few weeks, we will spend time developing a sound understanding of numbers and the number system through place value (what numbers are worth). We will then move onto addition and subtraction. As always, there will be a great emphasis on using our maths skills for problem solving and using them in other subjects where possible. In science we will be learning about the human body, including discussing the importance of exercise and healthy eating.



PE

Year 2 will have Indoor PE on a Wednesday and Outdoor PE on a Friday. The children must bring their PE uniform on these days. They will need a black jacket, joggers/ leggings and outdoor footwear such as trainers.

Please make sure all items of uniform are clearly named to prevent them being lost.

This half term we will be focusing on 'Team Building' and learning the fundamental skills required in PE lessons.

Homework

Spellings will be given at the start of the half-term with weekly tests on a Friday.

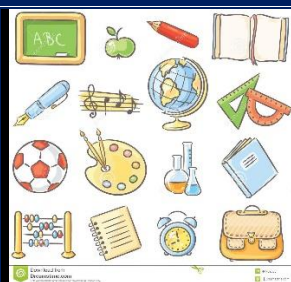
It is expected that children will regularly, every day if possible. Reading books will be checked, and changed weekly when children have read several times at home. Please remember to sign your child's reading record whenever you have listened to them read or discussed what they have read. We will shortly introduce the children to the 'Reading Flower'. Every time children read 5 times they will then be able to work their way up the flower. When children reach 50 reads, they will be rewarded with a certificate and a treat! When children reach one hundred reads, they will be again be treated with a certificate, a treat and the golden bee pin to symbolise our classes busy bee star readers! Reading is the fundamental foundation to learning across all subjects and the more a child reads, the more they unlock their potential to improve learning skills.

Other homework will be given as necessary to support in class learning. This will often include sheets to reinforce what we have been learning in the classroom.

How can I help my child?

Ensure your child arrives at school on time.

Ensure your child brings their reading book and reading record to school every day. Help and encourage your child to practice their spellings at home. Send your child to school with indoor PE kit on a Wednesday and outdoor PE kit on a Friday. I am sure we will have an amazing first term and I am looking forward to getting to know the children and yourselves even better!
