Dear Parents & Carers

On Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> March we would like to visit the Tropical Butterfly House Wildlife Conservation Park in North Anston with Year 1 & 2.

The Tropical Butterfly House offers a unique opportunity for children to explore a tropical rainforest environment, encounter exotic animals, and learn about wildlife conservation. The park is home to a variety of fascinating creatures, including butterflies, birds, bats, reptiles, and more. Students will have the chance to participate in interactive animal encounters and educational activities that will enhance their understanding of nature and biodiversity.

During the visit, students will attend two educational talks:

1. **Minibeasts:** This talk will introduce children to the world of small creatures such as insects, spiders, and other invertebrates. They will learn about the important roles these tiny animals play in the ecosystem and how to identify different species.
2. **Fur, Feathers & Scales:** This talk will focus on the diversity of animal coverings and the unique adaptations that help them survive in their habitats. Students will have the chance to see and touch different animal skins, feathers, and scales, enhancing their understanding of animal biology.

We will be leaving school at 8.30am so we ask that children should arrive promptly at school by 8:15am and will be returning for the end of the school day.

The cost of the trip is £26.00 per child, which covers transportation, entry fees, and the educational talks. To make payment and give parental consent, please log onto your MCAS account and select the trip under 'Products', where you can then pay for the trip and provide your consent at the same time. Payment is due by Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025.
