Year 6 National Childhood Measurement Programme (NCMP).

Every year in England, school children in reception and year 6 have their height and weight checked as part of the NCMP. The programme is delivered in school by our staff and your child will be measured fully clothed, except for their coat and shoes, in line with Local and National guidance.

All results are treated confidentially, and will not be given to your child or their school. The measurements are used to understand how many children are of a healthy weight, underweight or overweight; and are used to help plan support for children in the local area. For more information, please see the links below.

Please note that in Wakefield we do not send a letter with your child's results for NCMP. If your child is above or below a healthy weight, you may be contacted by us to further discuss this.
